Dear Parents,

Although the week was somewhat disrupted, the children have taken part in a range of book related activities, with teachers

mainly choosing picture books to use as a stimulus. Of course, we want to get our children actually decoding words and reading for meaning, but picture books can be a great way to share an enjoyment of books, promote book talk and develop those higher order inference and deduction skills. I believe that no home book collection is complete without a few picture books and that as parents, talking to our children about books, is almost as important as actually reading the words with them.

Of course reading is one area where you can support your child at home, but here's a reminder of a few others. Some are activities you could do daily, whilst others may help to keep them occupied during school holidays.

- Recite the days of the week/months of the year/alphabet/times tables forwards and backwards, in a high voice, low voice, squeaky voice etc.
- Play games to improve mental arithmetic dominoes, cards, pontoon (without the gambling aspect obviously), darts, top trumps.

- Write a diary including a log of any spending

- Write instructions for an alien to do an everyday task
- Write and illustrate a short story for younger children
- Cook something measuring, weighing, timing
- Re-write the ending to a wellknown story.

REMINDER Pupil Premium

If you are on a low income making a FSM application can greatly benefit your child.

It is often thought that parents of children in KS1 who currently receive Universal Free School Meals do not need to make a Free School Meals Application for the school to receive Pupil Premium. THIS IS NOT THE CASE.

Please read the linked information letter which explains that any accepted applications for Free School Meals (whether or not your child takes the meal up) attract £1320 per child per year which the school can use to greatly enhance the resources available for your child both within the classroom and for extracurricular activities. We may be able to help with school uniform costs, trips and other extra curricular activities like swimming and music tuition.
