Physical Development

Reception children

Every day children will be engaged in some form of physical activity. Children will not always change into a PE kit for such activities. We will let you know when children will need a PE kit - NOT YET! Year One children

We know that when school and home work together, children will benefit. Reception parents: At the end of September, after we have assessed everyone's skills, your child will bring home a folder full of letter sounds and words or books (whichever is appropriate and matches their needs). Please look through these resources with your child every day.

Don't forget to refer to your child's 'Next Steps' sheet that will come home after half term. This will contain information on key skills that your child will be learning.

Year 1 parents: Read and talk about books every day and use the advice in your child's yellow reading record book. As children become more confident at decoding and recognising words encourage them to look out for punctuation and begin to read with expression.

Spelling homework will come home once a week on a Wednesday. Work on maths skills as you go about your daily routines - count objects around you, chant the number names as far as you can.

Don't forget to refer to the year one and two 'Overview of learning' page. This will contain information on specific key skills that your child will be learning.

What does my child need at school everyday?


- A named and full water bottle.
